It is especially suitable for improving the flow out behaviour of Polyurethane based coats, avoid "orange peel effect" or "fish eye" while spraying or roller coating. It does not alter the softness or retard anchorage.

LEVELLER 168 improves the homogeneity of imparted film. The product is normally used in phase of application of non - solvent based fixative agents and top coats.

Usage

Stir before use 

Generally 10-20 gram Leveller 168 per kg. of polyurethane season is enough to get better flow out behaviour without affecting the inter-coat adhesion or rheology of system.
